<b>Earthenware</b>	 <b>101 Rocket White</b>	Smooth bright white low-fire body. Very plastic with excellent machanical working properties. Recomeded firing range is cone <b>07-03</b> . This is the best throwing white earthenware we have ever found.	12	<b>All clay is sold in 50 lb boxes at \$37.98 per box.</b>
	 <b>107 Gator Red</b>	A low fire, red terra cotta clay. At cone <b>06</b> this clay gives a light orange color, and at cone 2 will be dark red brown. This is a smooth, plastic red clay, ideal for wheel work.	6	
	<b>Gumbo</b>	<b>110 Gumbo</b>	Gumbo clay is the result of purging our mixer between batches of different clay. A guaranteed surprise in every bag, with some of this and some of that. Suitable for cone <b>04</b> firing.	3
<b>Mid-Range Stoneware</b>	 <b>212 Black Pepper</b>	This is a relatively smooth, stoneware type clay, which may be fired at <b>cone 4 - 6</b> . When fired this clay is light brown with darker speckles. Good clay for throwing or sculpture.	3	
	 <b>221 Salmon</b>	A reddish, mid-range clay. This clay fires to a light orange-brown hue, and may be fired from <b>cone 4 - 6</b> . This clay has 3% grog but is quite smooth, making it great for wheel throwing or sculpting.	3	
	 <b>241 Wheat Stone</b>	Mid-range stoneware with a warm wheat color in oxidation. Smooth clay, good for throwing or handbuilding. Fires at <b>cone 4 - 6</b> .	3
