On a separate tile we will show you how to use Quick-Crackle, so the piece can easily be finished after firing.



- Project 2 – Serenity - a Blue Heron in Silhouette form, project completed with EZ-Strokes, a Glaze Fan Brush with detailing completed with a Round and Liner Brush.
