

Join David Hoff at Still Mid-Town Ceramics

July 30 and 31, 2011

David Hoff is an internationally known Fired Art Educator, who has written the Duncan Educational program for over 24 years, travels throughout the world conducting workshops and classes as well as a contributing author for Fired Arts Magazine. He brings with him, his vast knowledge of ceramics in general, along with his expertise with airbrushing, brushwork and piping.

Saturday, July 30th Projects – Airbrushing Workshop

This workshop is designed to teach as much about using an airbrush as possible in one day. Students will complete three pieces of green ware during the workshop. Pieces can be varied with each student. Pieces include:



- Project 1: A plain piece such as Vase, Pitcher, Flower Pot or other – this is our first project, teaching general use of airbrush, shading of colors, and color combinations that work. Usually completed in Monotone shading. For the adventuresome student a newspaper surprise technique may be completed.



- Project 2: Animal of Choice – Lions, tigers and bears ---OH MY! That's right animals of your choice, frogs, turtles, rabbits, dogs, cats and of course the lions, tigers and bears. (Tigers not recommended). This project explains proper cross shading, reverse shading and natural blending of color, to achieve a natural look to complete animals.



- Project 3: Bird of Choice – Eagles, Owls, Rooster or Hen---again students have a choice of piece to complete. This project helps demonstrate closer and more detailed work with an airbrush, plus in some cases use of more colors. Note, if a bird is not desired bring a second animal of choice.

Sunday, July 31st Projects - More Fun with Airbrushing

This workshop is designed to give you some additional skills with an airbrush, plus show several interesting and exciting techniques. We will complete two green ware projects.



- Project 1 Wipe out design with Sgraffito work. A variety of colors will be airbrushed over a plate, platter, deep-dish. A top color will be airbrushed and from there we will add some wiping out and then Sgraffito. This is a great project and teaches a variety of techniques.



- Project 2 Fantastic Autumn Pumpkins (A **NEW** Project), we will airbrush and shade the pumpkins in bright oranges and golds. When finished we will use silk maple leaves as a stencil and airbrush leaves all over our airbrushed pieces. With a Liner brush the leaves will be accented and detailed. When finished you will want to do several more pumpkins for the upcoming Autumn Season.

These projects are a little more time consuming, for that reason there is only two scheduled for this day.

Each day's workshop fee will be \$ 65.00 for the entire day.

Workshops will start at 9:00am, lunch will be provided and the workshop is scheduled to end around 5:00pm.

In order to cover the instructor's travel expenses (flight, rental car and hotel costs), we need at least 10 per workshop. We also have to have everyone signed up and fees paid prior to July 15th.
